Material fee covers PMC, stones and in-class use of all necessary tools.

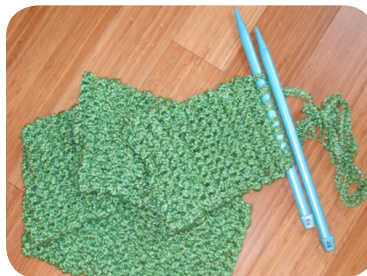


### Make a Soldered Necklace
